1. The debate will consist of several rounds, with each candidate having an equal opportunity to speak.
2. Each candidate will be given a set amount of time to respond to each question.
3. The order of the candidates will be determined randomly for each round.
4. The moderator will ask the questions and enforce the time limits.

Question Sourcing Guidelines:

1. Questions will be sourced from the community through a committee formed from the sponsors and selected individuals from within the community.
2. The committee will create non-partisan themes and a pool of questions for the moderator to choose from.
3. Questions will prioritize issues important to the Prosper ISD voters and allow candidates to provide substantive and detailed answers.

Pre-Debate Questions:

1. We will send advance questions submitted by the community and sponsors that cannot be addressed during the live debate. The deadline for these questions to be sent to each candidate will be 3/20, and responses will be released at 6:30 PM on the evening of the debate. Answering these questions is optional.
